Following on from Nigel Ayton's e-mail (below), I'm pleased to see that most of the relevant documents are now on the website. However the actual proposal for 19/02260/TCO - 13 Dalrymple Crescent - is still missing. All we know is that the intention is '30% removal'. In my view that is almost more than would be acceptable (depending on how it is done), but I would also be concerned that if the work were carried out at this time of year the health of the trees could be adversely affected.

I'd be grateful for any influence you may be able to exert on the applicant at least to let us know how and when he/she proposes to do the work.

Graham,

There have been four public notifications of applications for tree work in the Grange in the last day or so. The automated update is copied below. None of these includes any documentation uploaded to the planning portal, and so we are in the dark as to the details of any of these proposals, other than the very brief description in the titles. This is especially unsatisfactory for application [19/02237/TCO](#) at 59 Dick Place, which is listed simply as "Numerous tree works".

Can I ask please that you upload the relevant documents to the portal prior to making a decision on each case, with priority given to case 19/02237/TCO?

I appreciate that applications for tree work are not subject to public consultation. Nonetheless, the process does require public notification and this process is wholly ineffective if there are no details uploaded to the portal until after a decision has been made.
